





Application Methods:

-Ground: >15 GPA

-Air: >5 GPA

-Chemigation: Less than 0.50 inch

■ PHI: 3 Days*

REI: 24 Hours

Start applications prior to the onset of disease infection. The use of an adjuvant may improve disease control.
