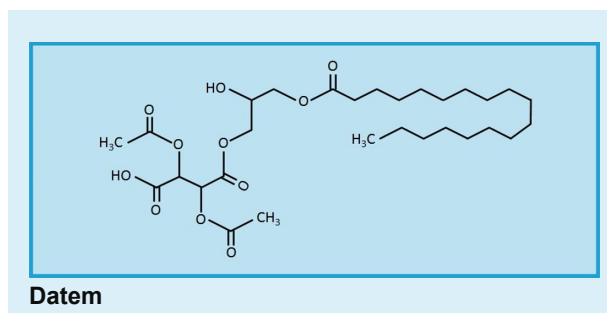

## Composition

Ingredients in descending order of weight:  
Mono- and diacetyl tartaric acid esters of mono- and diglycerides of fatty acids (E 472e).

## Standards

Lametop<sup>®</sup> 3XX Liquid complies with the current specifications established by the Joint FAO/WHO Expert Committee on Food Additives (JECFA) and the current EU Regulation laying down specifications for food additives.

## Storage conditions

The product should be stored at temperatures below 20 °C, in a dry place.

## Shelf life

In its unopened original package under the mentioned conditions the product has a shelf life of 12 months. If stored at 60 °C for improved flowability, the maximum shelf life is 14 days.

## Applications

Application in yeast raised products to obtain products with higher volume and equal crumb structure, e.g. baguette, white bread, crispy rolls.

## Dosing

The recommended dosage of Lametop® 3XX Liquid in yeast raised products is 0.2 – 0.5 % based on flour weight.
