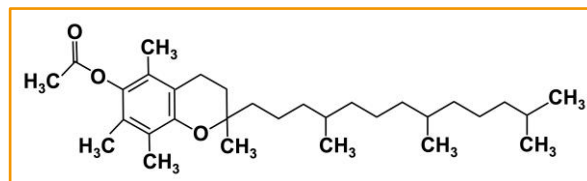

Solubility	soluble in hydrocarbons, alcohols, fats and oils; insoluble in water

Stability and storage

The product should be stored not above 25°C, in a dry place and protected from light. In the unopened, original packaging the product is stable for at least 36 months.

Handling

Carefully close the packaging after removing partial amounts.

Application

For the preparation of liquid vitamin E preparations for oral use. In aqueous formulations, the use of solubilizers is necessary. For use in veterinary applications, where a European ASMF and CEP is accepted.
