Description

Opaque, deep-red suspension of mixed carotenoids in olive oil. The carotenoids are obtained from the alga *Dunaliella salina*. The product is packed under inert gas.

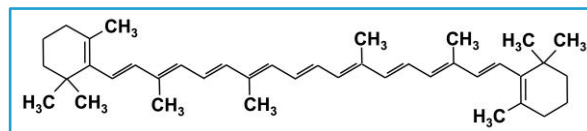

Stability and storage

Beta-carotene is sensitive to light, heat and oxygen and needs to be stored in a light-proof and airtight container. Stored in the unopened, original packaging at temperatures not above 30 °C, in a dry place, the product is stable for at least 60 months.

Handling

The product is a suspension, therefore settling of carotenoid crystals may occur after prolonged storage. It is strongly recommended that the suspension in the container is warmed and mixed thoroughly prior to sampling or use. Once opened, it is recommended to flush the packaging with an inert gas and to use the remaining contents as quickly as possible.

Applications

For use in foods (e.g., oils, margarine, spreads, cheese preparations) and beverages. When used in beverages, emulsification is required. The product is added to the oily phase.

Carotenoids from *Dunaliella salina* can be used as provitamin A source and as colorant. Suitability of these applications is presented based solely on technical feasibility. Local prevailing legal or regulatory requirements are not considered and should be observed separately. This product is not intended and recommended by BASF for use in food for infants and young children and has not been qualified by BASF for use in those applications with specific requirements.
