White to yellowish powder with a weak acetic acid odor.

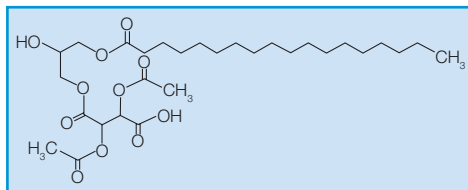
Datem on a carrier system of calcium carbonate. Used as an emulsifier for yeast raised products.

## Composition

Ingredients in descending order of weight: Mono- and diacetyl tartaric acid esters of mono- and diglycerides of fatty acids (E 472e), calcium carbonate (E 170), tricalcium phosphate (E 341(iii)).

## Standards

All additives used in Sanddorn comply with the current specifications established by the Joint FAO/WHO Expert Committee on Food Additives (JECFA) and the current EU Regulation laying down specifications for food additives. Manufactured under ISO 9001 as well as HACCP methodology.

## Storage conditions

The product should be stored at temperatures below 20 °C, in a dry place.

## Shelf life

In its unopened original package under the mentioned conditions the product has a shelf life of 15 months.

## Applications

Application in yeast raised products to obtain products with higher volume and equal crumb structure, e.g. baguette, white bread, crispy rolls.

## Dosing

The recommended dosage of Sanddorn in yeast raised products is 0.2 – 0.5% based on flour weight.
